Restrictions on ages to be calculated to Show Day

The **Peter Mingo Perpetual Challenge Cup** will be presented at **Kingsbridge Show** in September to the Exhibitor gaining the most point in the **Cattle Classes** at the three **Agricultural shows** of **Yealmpton, Totnes and Kingsbridge** during the season. **Competitors must compete at all three shows to be eligible for this cup.** First will be awarded 3 points, Second awarded 2 points and Third awarded 1 point for each class
